

# EDUCATOR PATHWAY



The Educator Pathway is a career opportunity for interprofessional staff who have education as a core component of their role at PHC.

The pathway is a 4-step curriculum that individuals are invited to apply to attend. The curriculum (full day sessions) include content on learning theories, program development, student-centered practices, and evaluative processes.

**1** For any clinical staff interested in learning how to support learning in one-on-one situations.

- **Clinical Teaching (Educator Pathway Level 1)**, 4 hours

**2** For any clinical staff currently supporting the learning of small groups in a practice area or who are interested in learning basic education theory and developing and applying education in practice.

- Education Theory & Practice, 8 days (58 hours)

**3** For experienced clinical educators who provide education for groups of diverse learners, across programs, disciplines or HSDA's.

- Educatory Theory & Practice, 5 days (36 hours)

**4** For clinical staff with 5 years practice experience and a minimum of a Bachelors degree who wants to work in a new cross sector role and complete a Masters of Nursing with an education focus or certificate/degree in adult education.

- Professional practice & education leadership & practice, formal post-graduate qualifications
